Samdy Simpson introduced our speakers...Amanda Minor and James Young from the Douglas County Health Department. They are looking for volunteers for a new program...TASK (Trust Appreciation Support with Kindness). This is funded by a grant.

This is a Douglas County mentoring program to serve young peoople from kindergarten through high school in one-to-one mentoring relationships. These relationships foster strong 1 to 1 mentormentee bonds that provide support and guidance to chileren/youth.

Each mentor is asked for one year commitment, but encouraged to continue through the mentee's high school graduation. Each mentor volunteer is expected to spend time with their mentee 3-4 times a month for a few hours doing normal everyday activities, like seeing a movie, doing homework, playing games, going out to eat, etc. The program pays for the required background checks. Other volunteer opportunity to support this program iniclude administrative support, event planning, outreach, and special projects.

This program cannot have any association with Kiwanis International or our club, as it requires 1-1 adult/youth interaction.

- 2. <u>2025 Garage Sale</u> The Board reviewed the garage sale results. The survey responses showed there is enough interest and support to host this fundraiser in 2025. The Board agreed to move forward with the sale. For those 18 members who indicated they would serve on the core committee, Janet will call a committee meeting to select the 4 days that we will need the Community Building, based on availability of core committee members. After discussion, Janet Butler made a motion to pay the KI insurance fees from the club foundation, and the dues and magazine from the club administrative account so that there are sufficient funds in the club account for 2024/2025. Ian Rominger seconded the motion and it was approved.
